

Kitten Charter

We have been working with breeders for over 40 years to provide 4 weeks free insurance to kittens when they leave for their new homes. This provides peace of mind for breeders and helps new owners get the best veterinary care possible for the new addition to their family.

Our aim is to provide an ethical, efficient and friendly service, valuable to both breeders and your new owners at all times in accordance with good industry practice. In addition to the Petplan Breeder Scheme Terms and Conditions, the Breeder Charter outlines our expectations of breeders participating in the Petplan Breeder Scheme to help ensure all the breeders that work with us, breed and sell kittens responsibly. By activating 4 weeks free Petplan insurance, you agree to abide by this charter and comply with the following:



About you:

1. If you meet the criteria where you need to be licensed under the laws and regulations in the country where you reside and carry out cat breeding/selling activities, you must:
 - Hold a valid licence for this activity from your licensing authority.
 - At all times, fully adhere to the requirements of this licence.
 - Send a copy and subsequent renewals of your breeding licence to Petplan.
2. You have never been and are not currently the subject of any investigations by any local authority, trading standards or other regulatory body.
3. You accept that Petplan continually monitors claims made on Instant Kitten Policies and if there are any concerns, Petplan has the right to amend or withdraw your authority to issue Instant kitten Policies.
4. You understand that Instant Kitten Policies cannot be issued to yourself, any member of your family, anyone who lives with you, or any person employed as part of the breeding business.
5. You understand that it is your responsibility to inform Petplan as soon as possible by phone/email if you no longer comply with any aspect of this charter.
6. You understand that Petplan has the right to amend or withdraw your authority to issue Instant Kitten Policies at any time, and that in this scenario Breeder Bonus Credits are also forfeited.

About the queen:

1. The queen has not had more than three litters in any two-year period, and has been given sufficient time to recover body weight and condition between litters.

About the kittens:

1. You have bred and own the litter.
2. You are satisfied to the best of your knowledge and veterinary advice in your possession that all kittens sold:
 - Are in good health and have not knowingly been exposed to any infectious or contagious disease.
 - Show no sign of infestation by fleas, lice, mites or ringworm.
 - Are at least 8 weeks of age and less than 12 months old.
 - Have been socialised and handled regularly since birth.
3. You will tell the kitten buyer (before collection) and Petplan (when activating cover) about any illness or injury the kitten has suffered from including any symptoms of an illness or injury.
4. **Vaccinations:**
 - Conventional (i.e. not homoeopathic) vaccinations will be used, and administered by a veterinary surgeon.
 - All kittens sold at the age of 12 weeks or older will have been given at least their 1st vaccination and thereafter appropriately vaccinated in accordance with a veterinary surgeon's advice.
 - Where appropriate a vaccination certificate must be given to each kitten buyer and this must be signed by a veterinary surgeon and show the date(s) the vaccination(s) was given.
5. **Worming:**
 - All kittens must be wormed with a veterinary approved wormer at least twice before sale.
 - Each kitten buyer will be provided with written confirmation, signed by you, showing the dates of worming and the brand of wormer used.
6. If you are selling the kitten as registered with an association/club, the kitten will be registered with the association/club by you prior to sale. You will provide the kitten buyer with a signed form in the association's/club's approved format.
7. Any defects or any other matters which a breeder of reasonable experience might consider to be relevant to a kitten buyer's decision to purchase the kitten in accordance with good industry practice will be pointed out to the kitten buyer.
